

Although this event seems to be "far off" you must realise that the hospitality industry is facing difficulties especially where groups book and are let down by low numbers, again we are in the market where lucrative weekend wedding events compete for business, and these are booked sometimes years in advance. Large corporate hotel chains such as Premier Inns and Travel Lodge tend to cater for individual needs. Raven Hall Hotel is a private family run business and therefore cannot afford to be let down. I only put this out, not only to encourage you to take up their offer, but to explain the reasons behind cut off and booking dates, and the requirement for deposits. A proposal has been received for Howard Pidd to join the committee. Please note that Jacqui Naylor is currently co-opted onto the committee as webmaster. David Naylor is happy to continue as auditor.

According to the Club Rules:

Should you wish to stand for election to any position then please would you submit a proposal to that effect, signed by another member, to be with the secretary not less than 7 days before the AGM.

If you wish to add to the agenda then please submit your proposal, seconded by 2 members, to the secretary at least 14 days before the AGM. Alternatively, the matter may be raised under any other business, provided that a majority of those present agree.

There are three amendments offered to the proposed new Club Rules which, if there are no objections, will be incorporated into the final version, approved at the AGM and promulgated by email shortly thereafter:

Firstly, Sub-Para 3.2 states:

'Joint Members. Full Members may apply for Joint Membership where they wish their spouse, partner, children and/or stepchildren to join. Benefits and rights are the same as for Full Members, except that only one copy of the Club magazine and newsletters will be sent to the couple.'

Despite the text using the word 'couple', the wording implies that several children and/or stepchildren could potentially become joint members. Therefore it is proposed to change the wording to:

'Full Members may apply for Joint Membership where they wish their spouse or partner or one of their children and/or stepchildren to join. Benefits and rights are the same as for Full Members, except that only one copy of the Club magazine and newsletters will be sent to the couple.'

Secondly and thirdly, there are inconsistencies in the wording of timescales in 2 paras: Most timescales that are specified are in days; therefore it is proposed to change Para 6, 'six weeks' to '42 days' and Sub-para 9.3 'one month' to '30 days'.
