

AGM WEEKEND

THE PETWOOD HOTEL STIXWOULD ROAD, WOODHALL SPA, LINCOLNSHIRE, LN10 6QG



The 2024 AGM will take place over the weekend of the 27th - 29th September at the Petwood Hotel. It's fairly central location in the country gives the opportunity to attend whilst limiting the distance travelled and we hope that will maximise attendance.

Please book your accommodation directly with the hotel, saying that you are with the Naylor Car Club, on 01526 352411. The cost is £200 for a double room and £157.50 for a single, dinner, B&B, extra nights £10 less. Rooms must be booked by 26th July and will involve a deposit of £50pp which is refundable up to 7 days prior. Please feel free to make your own B&B arrangements and if you wish to join us for dinner the charge is £45pp which must be booked and paid for 14 days prior. Menu choices for the 3 course dinner will need to be made a couple of weeks before for the first night and then on the morning after for subsequent nights, which I will co-ordinate.

Entry fee for the weekend is £30 per car, to cover the cost of the rally plate and attendance plaque etc.

Activities will start on Friday 27th with a visit to the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight (BBMF) at the nearby RAF Coningsby at 1400hrs. The guided tour takes about one and a half hours to complete and gives the opportunity to see whatever is available in the hangar, as allowed by the flying and maintenance programme. Provided we get at least 15 people interested, the discounted cost is £10.35 for adults and £9.00 for concessions which needs to be paid by us in a lump sum, so please make payment to the Club account, sent in with the entry fee.

Other things to do in Lincolnshire include:

The Bubble car Museum Boston, Seal Sanctuary Mablethorpe, Tattershall Castle, Bomber Command Centre Lincoln, Museum of Lincolnshire Life Lincoln, Cogglesford Water Mill Sleaford, Cranwell Aviation Heritage Museum, Metheringham Airfield Visitor Centre, Mrs Smith's Cottage near Waddington, Lincolnshire Road Transport Museum Lincoln, Natureland Skegness, Lincolnshire Wolds Railway, Heckington Windmills and breweries.

Cadwell Park racetrack is not far away and I am enquiring with them whether there is any chance of a parade lap for our Naylors, depending on their programme. There are 4 roads in the area marked as 'scenic' routes on the map. There is also 'the Kinema in the Woods' in Woodhall Spa and we will see whether there is a suitable film to watch at a convenient time.

If you would like to join us, then please complete the form enclosed with this edition of the Naylor News and get it to me, Mike Chatterton, with payment into the NEW club bank account for the Club entry fee and BBMF entry fee. Looking forward to seeing you there!


